THIRD SUNDAY of EASTER



In today's gospel we meet the disheartened disciples on the Road to Emmaus, a road out of Jerusalem. Being discouraged at the death of Jesus, they have an encounter with Christ that changes them forever. Jesus met them where they were, listened to them and opened their minds and hearts. something familiar, "he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them" and by doing this, their eyes were opened and they recognized him. Jesus is with us at every Mass in the scripture we hear and in the breaking of the bread - in the Eucharist. Do we recognize him there? Like those early disciples, after receiving Christ in the Eucharist will we say, 'Were not our hearts burning within us...?'" Let us pray for one another that our hearts will "burn within" each time we receive Jesus in Holy Communion.





May 11 - Episode 4: The Rock On Which It Is Built


May 18 - Episode 5: The Wedding Gift




