Our readings today give us a clear description of what our parishes are to be and how we are to live as disciples. In the reading from Acts, the author describes the life of the disciples in this way: “The community of believers were of one heart and mind. . . they bore witness to Christ.” Does this describe our parish, our community of believers? Is unity a hallmark of our community? Our efforts at strengthening our community and living faithfully as disciples may at times leave us feeling discouraged and doubtful, Jesus’ words in today’s gospel urge us to keep believing in him, even when our faith is weak. May we take comfort in Jesus’ words, “Blessed are those who have not seen me, but still believe.”

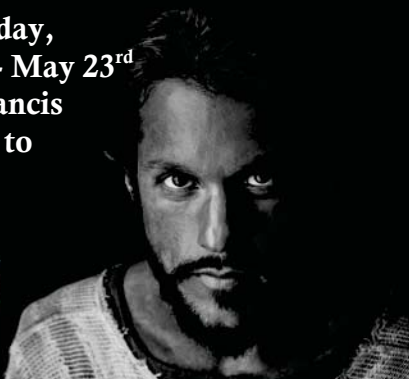

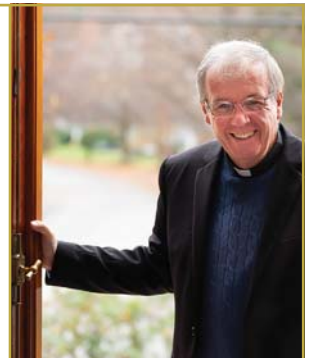

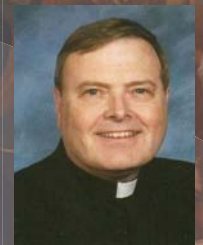
